

# Australia Post – Shipping Plugin

The nopCommerce systems allows the installation and setup of Shipping Plugins which can be used to automatically calculate the shipping costs associated with the sale and delivery or particular products.

#### Store View – Estimate Shipping


When a product that requires shipping is added to the cart then the Estimate Shipping function can be used. The cost to send a package via Australia Post can be estimated.



#### Store View - Checkout Options

As part of the checkout process the user will be presented with a number of options for selecting the shipping.

#### Checkout




The user can select the desired shipping option being either Regular or Express Post

#### **Checkout Attributes**

The plugin configuration has the option to set up a number of Checkout attributes associated with Australia Post shipping. These are


- Extra Cover Insurance
- Signature on Delivery
- Email Track Advice

The attributes will then be displayed in the checkout as follows. The user can then decide to select to select the desired option:



The options selected and additional costs are then displayed in the shopping cart and added to the final cost to purchase.

#### Administration

The backend Administration has several pages for managing the setup of Shipping using the Australia Post plugin. The setup created by the standard install can be changed using the following functions detailed below:

#### Installing the Plugin

The zip package supplied can be uploaded and installed using the "Upload plugin or theme" button on the Configuration > plugins page.

Alternatively, you can manually install the plugin:

- 1. Copy the Plugin to the correct directory
- 2. Restart the Application Click the Icon in the top

Once installed the you can configure the plugin.

#### **Multistore Configuration**

The plugin supports multistore configurations. Select All Stores to setup the settings for All Stores or alternatively select the store and customise the settings for the particular store.


#### **Configure Settings**

The settings for the plugin can be set using the configure page. To setup the plugin or define the options open the config page in the Menu then click the required function checkbox. After entering the settings click **Save.** 

There are two tabs to select the confuration options

- Australia Post Configuration
- System API and Warehouse API Settings

#### **Australia Post Configuration**



#### Additional Handling Charge

You can enter an additional fee that is added to the base charges received from Australia Post. This fee will be automatically added to all shipping options displayed.

#### **Install Checkout Attributes**

To enable the shipping attributes (as Checkout attributes) click on the Install Checkout Attributes checkbox. Refer to Checkout Attributes below

#### **Restricted Product Mode**

When this mode is selected then products which have a **Restricted Product Tag** assigned will not use the Australia Post shipping method to calculate a shipping estimate.

#### **Restricted Product Tags**

A list of the restricted product tags which are checked

#### **Display Lowest Cost**

If this option is selected then only the lowest costs options for Express and Regular shipping is displayed.

Note: If more that two options are displayed then you need to check the System Log to find out which method is not defined in the Ignore Services list

#### **Ignore Services**

When a query is set to the Australia Post website it will return data detailing the types of services to send packages based on the dimensions and weight of the package.

- A full list of service available are displayed in the Ignore Services multiselector.
- Click on the services that are to be ignored, which means they <u>will not</u> be displayed as options for the customer to select in the front-end functions.

#### Option Find, Option Replace, Optional Prefix (normally "Australia Post - ")

These fields can be used to customise the naming of the option(s) displayed to the user.

To replace the prefix (normally "Australia Post – ") edit the value in the Option Prefix box. To make it blank and remove the prefix enter \*

To replace text in the option enter the value to replace in the 'Option Find' field and the enter the text that that will replace it in the 'Option Replace' field. To replace it with nothing text enter \*

#### For example, using these settings

To replace the prefix edit the value in the Option Prefix box. T	o make it blank and remove the prefix enter *
To replace text in the option enter the value to replace in the $$	'Option Find' field and the enter the text that that will replace it in the 'Option Replace' field. To replace it with blank text enter



#### System API and Warehouse API Settings



#### Australia Post API Key

The API key can be obtained by registering for an account to do "API access to PAC and Postcode Search"

#### **Purchased Licence Keys**

When you first install the plugin Demonstration keys will be automatically generated. The plugin can be operated in demo mode for 14 days.

The purchase licence keys will be provided via email normally within 1 day after purchase. The purchase licence keys can then be entered as follows:

#### Public Key

This is the plugin licence public key provided. When you first install the plugin a Demonstration key will be saved. Change this value to the Public key suppled in the email when received.

#### Private Key

This is the plugin licence public key provided. When you first install the plugin a Demonstration key will be saved. Change this value to the Private key suppled in the email when received.

#### Warehouse API Settings


If you operate multiple warehouses and you have multiple API Keys which are different for each warehouse then enter the keys. Note: you do not need to enter keys for each warehouse unless they are different to the default API Key enter above

#### **Test Configuration**

Note: This button has no function at present


#### **Display Lowest Cost**

If you select this option the plugin will search and find all package shipping options and then select the lowest cost option for both Regular and Express post. Only these options will be displayed to the customer.




#### **Checkout Attributes**

When enabled the following options will then be displayed in the checkout



If the detailed setup provided by the standard install needs to be changed this can be done using the admin function

**Catalog** → **Attributes** → **Checkout attributes** 



#### **Defining Products**

When setting up Products you can define the Shipping details that will be used to calculate the shipping cost



To enable shipping for a product, click the Shipping enabled checkbox.


Then enter the estimated or exact weight, length, width and height of package for the item to be shipped.

#### **Access Control**

Before you can access the configure menu options you need to setup access control to manage access to configure the Plugin


Go to Configuration > Access Control List

Select the Manage Plugins in the desired Customer role to enable access to configure the plugin.




#### **Shipping Rate Computation Methods**

Once the Plugin is installed it will be displayed in the Shipping Rate Computation page. To enable the Australia Post shipping option, edit the option and activate it.



#### **Shipping Settings**

There are various settings which control the operation of the Shipping Rate Computation.





#### Measures

The plugin requires that the following setup in Measures


- 1. Mark meter(s) as the Primary dimension and ensure Ratio to primary dimensions is set as 1
- 2. Adjust millimetres(s) and ensure Ratio to primary dimension is set at 1000
- 3. Mark kg(s) as the Primary Weight and ensure Ratio to primary dimensions is set as 1
- 4. Adjust grams(s) and ensure Ratio to primary weight is set at 1000



#### All settings

All settings for the plugin can be edited using the All Settings Editor

**Configuration** → **Settings** → **All Settings** 



AvailableIgnoreServcices is a list of service that are displayed in the multiselector on the configuration page.

Over time new services may be introduced by Australia Post. If you find these services being displayed in the front end to the customer and you wish to be able to ignore them then edit this setting and add the new service at the end of the list.

**IgnoreServcices** is a list of service that have been ignored and will not be displayed when search of available postage options using the front-end functionality.

Note: The items are comma separated - do not change this formatting or it will cause an error
